A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

This Wednesday is not only Valentine's Day, but also Ash Wednesday. I do not recall that happening before, but who knows? This is a year where we get through Lent by the end of March.

Lent is a time we try to deepen our relationship with Jesus through fasting, almsgiving and prayer. It is a good time to have a small direct way to do this that is sustainable and will help you get closer to Jesus, not make you look good at the table when people ask, "What did you give up for Lent?"

As you look at new ways to do this, let me suggest a couple. This is a great time to get into a small group. For prayer we have Stations of the Cross on Thursday nights. We also have some Word Among Us Books to follow the daily readings. There is also a Mathew Kelly book available for Lent. For almsgiving and action, every Wednesday night we have Food Distribution to 300 families. We can always use help from 3 to 5:30 PM. There is also a great family activity on Saturday, March 16, when we go to the Feed My starving Children facility in Libertyville to pack meals for the poor starving children in third world countries.

My advice is keep it simple. Don't let it be like a diet you start in January. Make it be something you can and will do that will make you a better person.

Lenten Regulations for Fast/Abstinence

Abstinence: All persons who have completed their 14th year are bound by the law of abstinence.

Fast: All adults are bound by the law of fast from the beginning of their 19th year up to the beginning of their 60th year.

Application: The law of abstinence forbids the eating of meat and foods prepared with meat or meat by-products. The law of fast allows only one full meal and two lighter meals in the course of a day, and prohibits eating between meals.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All other Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Women who are pregnant and persons who are sick are not bound by the law of fast.

Ayuno y abstinencia para Cuaresma

Abstinencia: Todas las personas que han cumplido los 14 años están obligadas por la ley de abstinencia.

Ayuno: Todos los adultos están sujetos a la ley del ayuno desde el comienzo de los 19 añoshasta el comienzo de los 60 años.

Como y cuando hacerio: La ley de la abstinencia prohibe comer carne y alimentos preparados con carne o derivados de la carne. La ley del ayuno permite solo una comida complete y dos comidas ligeras en el transcurso del dia, y prohibe comer entre comidas.

El Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo son dias de ayuno y abstinencia. Todos los demás Viernes de Cuaresma son dias de abstinencia únicamente.

Excepsiones: Las mujeres embarazadas y las personas enfermas no están sujetas a la ley del ayuno.
