A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

This Wednesday is not only Valentine's Day, but also Ash Wednesday. I do not recall that happening before, but who knows? This is a year where we get through Lent by the end of March.

Lent is a time we try to deepen our relationship with Jesus through fasting, almsgiving and prayer. It is a good time to have a small direct way to do this that is sustainable and will help you get closer to Jesus, not make you look good at the table when people ask, "What did you give up for Lent?"

As you look at new ways to do this, let me suggest a couple. This is a great time to get into a small group. For prayer we have Stations of the Cross on Thursday nights. We also have some Word Among Us Books to follow the daily readings. There is also a Mathew Kelly book available for Lent. For almsgiving and action, every Wednesday night we have Food Distribution to 300 families. We can always use help from 3 to 5:30 PM. There is also a great family activity on Saturday, March 16, when we go to the Feed My starving Children facility in Libertyville to pack meals for the poor starving children in third world countries.

My advice is keep it simple. Don't let it be like a diet you start in January. Make it be something you can and will do that will make you a better person.

Lenten Regulations for Fast/Abstinence

Abstinence: All persons who have completed their 14th year are bound by the law of abstinence.

Fast: All adults are bound by the law of fast from the beginning of their 19th year up to the beginning of their 60th year.

Application: The law of abstinence forbids the eating of meat and foods prepared with meat or meat by-products. The law of fast allows only one full meal and two lighter meals in the course of a day, and prohibits eating between meals.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All other Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Women who are pregnant and persons who are sick are not bound by the law of fast.


Start a Regular Adoration Time for Lent

Hearing Loop System in Church

If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with the telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the spoken word of the priest or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. If your hearing aid does not have the telecoil or "T" coil, it can be added. For those who do not have hearing aids, headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system are located in the Information Center for use during Mass.



Hermanos y hermanas, el próximo miércoles, con la imposición de las cenizas, daremos inicio al tiempo de Cuaresma. Como cada año este tiempo litúrgico nos invita a la conversión, al cambio de nuestras vidas; y precisamente por eso existe la tentación de no tomarlo muy en serio, sino hacerlo algo rutinario que se repite cada año.

Practicamos con mucha facilidad el hecho de la penitencia y abstinencia, junto con el ayuno que hacemos los días viernes de este tiempo. Sin embargo, quiero invitarlos a la práctica de la caridad con mayor fuerza para darle mayor y mejor sentido a esos sacrificios y ayunos que vamos a realizar.

Esta Cuaresma, para que realmente la hagamos un camino de conversión debe ser un tiempo donde expandamos la mira a aquellos que están pasando por momentos difíciles y están cerca de nosotros. Nada va a cambiar si no unimos el sacrificio personal que hacemos, los momentos de oración que podamos ofrecer a Dios, a las acciones de caridad hacia el hermano.

Por eso esta preparación no solo implica una reflexión sobre lo que vamos a hacer con respecto a nosotros mismos, sino también lo que haremos por nuestros hermanos.

La Cuaresma nos invita a “entrenarnos” espiritualmente, también mediante la práctica de la limosna, para crecer en la caridad y reconocer en los pobres a Cristo mismo. Esa es la finalidad. Que Dios nos ayude a tener una santa cuaresma, enfocada en la ayuda al hermano necesitado a través de la caridad.



Ayuno y abstinencia para Cuaresma

Abstinencia: Todas las personas que han cumplido los 14 años están obligadas por la ley de abstinencia.

Ayuno: Todos los adultos están sujetos a la ley del ayuno desde el comienzo de los 19 años hasta el comienzo de los 60 años.

Como y cuando hacerlo: La ley de la abstinencia prohíbe comer carne y alimentos preparados con carne o derivados de la carne. La ley del ayuno permite solo una comida completa y dos comidas ligeras en el transcurso del día, y prohíbe comer entre comidas.

El Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia. Todos los demás Viernes de Cuaresma son días de abstinencia únicamente.

Excepciones: Las mujeres embarazadas y las personas enfermas no están sujetas a la ley del ayuno.


