HEARING LOOP SYSTEM

If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. For those who do not have hearing aids, headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system are located in the Information Center for use during Mass.

Esto es un gran motivo para nosotros sentir muchas más ganas de hacer las cosas mejores en este tiempo de cuaresma, de tomar mucho más en serio este tiempo de reflexión y cambio de vida.

Esa samaritana representa al ser humano sediento de felicidad; ella había intentado muchas veces encontrar la felicidad en sus relaciones personales; pero Jesús le muestra un agua que calma su sed de ser feliz: su misma persona.

Muchas veces buscamos esa felicidad en cosas que son temporales y sin importancia que pertenecen a este mundo, pero Jesús nos invita a reflexionar sobre cómo dejamos que "su agua viva" calme todo lo que está árido en nosotros. Jesús es esa agua en el desierto que calma la sed de cualquier situación que el hombre pueda estar viviendo.

El agua que Jesús ofreció a aquella mujer la hizo sentir amada y no rechazada por su historia personal. El Señor no solo calma nuestra sed, sino que limpia todo aquello que podamos tener "sucio" en nuestro corazón. Lo que debe guiarnos es aquella misma petición que le dijo la mujer a Jesús: "dame de esa agua para más nunca tener sed".

En esta cuaresma que podamos acercarnos a la reconciliación, a ese momento donde Jesús nos limpia de nuestros pecados y calma nuestra sed de felicidad. Solo Él puede hacerlo y devolvernos nuestra dignidad de Hijos de Dios.
