A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

I hope everyone is enjoying Spring and hopefully we'll have continued good weather for spring sports and celebrations.

Our annual Diocesan Stewardship Appeal is here once again. We are actually starting a week early so I do not have to do this during the First Communion Masses. This year our goal is \$130,249. This is up about \$7,000 from last year for two reasons. The first is that our income went up last year and our goal is calculated on our income. The second is the overall diocesan goal has risen \$400,000. Half of this is to help Catholic Charities do their work. As we know the need has risen sharply here this year as the cost of basics has increased so much.

Once again, I ask that you give what you have done before and, if possible, a little more. If you have not given in the past, I ask that you please jump in. We will pay this amount no matter what, so it is best we take care of this first. Next week you should get the envelopes and information in the mail. I will talk about it at Mass and ask for a pledge. Thank you for your attention to this matter.



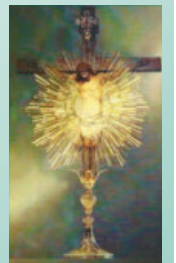

Jesus Calls You by Name: Be an Adorer

“But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you: I have called you by name, you are mine.” Isaiah 43:1

Have you ever considered Adoration? Catholics believe that “the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist” (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physical properties of bread, the **Real Presence of Jesus Christ**, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. Praying before the Eucharist, then, is praying before the presence of Jesus Christ. If you are interested in scheduling a permanent hour with Jesus or cannot commit weekly, sign-up as a substitute. 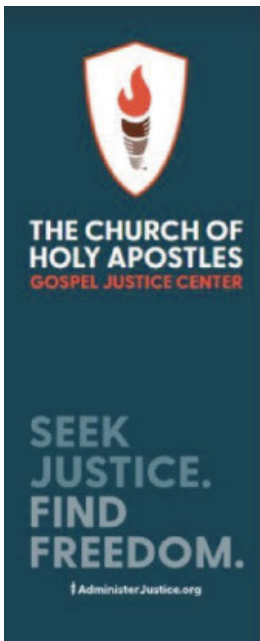

DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI

Hermanos y hermanas, hoy la liturgia de la Palabra nos presenta la figura del Buen Pastor, Jesús que conoce a sus ovejas y da la vida por cada una de ellas.

La figura de pastor es la más usada dentro del contexto bíblico, de igual forma Jesús, porque era la forma de conectar con aquellas personas que lo seguían, muchas de ellas tenían ese oficio, así el mensaje no solo era más claro, sino que cada uno se podía identificar con lo dicho.

En el domingo del Buen Pastor se ora principalmente por las vocaciones sacerdotales. Le pedimos a Dios que nos envíe sacerdotes que quieran trabajar por las ovejas que le pertenecen a Dios. Y precisamente hay algo que en esta época debemos tener presente y es la contradicción entre ser cristianos, orar por las vocaciones y ayudar a los sacerdotes. Pues bien, los sacerdotes no somos perfectos, somos seres humanos como cada uno de ustedes, que tenemos vida, pasado y cometemos errores. Dios no nos llama por ser los más capacitados, sino que Dios nos ha ido capacitando, en la medida que nos entregamos a Él, Dios capacita a los llamados. Sin embargo, una triste realidad es que los fieles en vez de apoyar y ayudar a sus sacerdotes, los critican o los señalan, muchas veces porque no les parece algo que dijo o hace. Se juega con la idea de “el Padre es bueno cuando hace lo que queremos”, pero es malo si dice que no.

Los sacerdotes tenemos una misión junto con la comunidad, estamos al servicio de ella y hemos dejado todo simplemente para servir a Dios y cada uno de ustedes.

Antes de hablar de nosotros los sacerdotes, yo te invitaría colocarte en nuestras situaciones, en nuestros zapatos y ver cómo es nuestra vida. Criticarnos no va a hacer que mejoremos, simplemente demuestra lo egoísta que muchas veces somos.

No podemos ir al templo y orar a Dios que nos dé sacerdotes y luego salimos a criticarlos y ponerlos mal, incluso llegando en algunos momentos a reportarlo por cosas que son más personales que otras cosas.

Hay que pedirle a Dios que nos envíe sacerdotes, pero también debemos apoyarlos. Es fácil criticar, pero es desafiante ayudarlos y brindarles una mano. 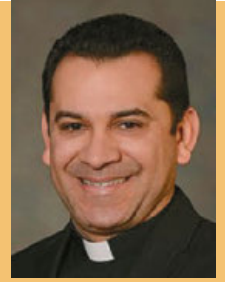
