#### **HEARING LOOP SYSTEM**

If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. For those who do not have hearing aids, headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system are located in the Information Center for use during Mass.

### Jesus Calls You by Name: Be an Adorer

"But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you: "I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

Have you ever considered Adoration? Catholics believe that "the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist" (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physical properties of bread, the **Real Presence of Jesus Christ**, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. Praying before the Eucharist, then, is praying before the presence of Jesus Christ. If you are interested in scheduling a

For Those Fleeing Their Own Countries. Let us pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys fraught with danger and violence, may find welcome and new living opportunities in their host countries.

### **DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI**

Hermanos y hermanas, ya estamos en junio, ya estamos a la mitad del año civil. Siempre es bueno a la mitad del camino, hacer un "stop" para revisar cómo ha sido nuestro camino recorrido hasta este momento. El mes de junio es dedicado al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, así como mayo es dedicado a Nuestra Madre Santísima.

Este domingo de manera especial celebramos Corpus Christi, el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Anteriormente se celebraba el jueves después de la Solemnidad de la Trinidad, pero por razones pastorales y facilitar que los fieles puedan cumplir con la solemnidad se traslada ahora al domingo; sin embargo, en algunos lugares se mantiene la tradición de celebrarlo del día jueves.

Hay dos cosas que debemos tener presente siempre a la hora de hablar del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús. Lo primero es que es un don de Dios, el mismo Jesús se ha querido quedar en medio de nosotros, para alimentar nuestra alma con su propio ser.

Lo segundo es que nadie es digno de recibir el Cuerpo de Jesús. No se trata de nuestra dignidad, sino del amor que Dios tiene por nosotros que se dona a sí mismo. Nadie puede atribuirse el derecho de decir "yo soy digno de recibirlo", ni mucho menos señalar a otra persona diciéndole que no es digna.

No debemos hablar de "dignidad para recibirlo", sino de "condiciones para poder recibirlo", porque como he dicho: nadie es digno de recibirlo, pero todos debemos tener condiciones para recibirlo. El Misterio del Cuerpo del Señor, es un don maravilloso que nos exige estar en gracia; por eso es necesario la confesión, la cercanía y participación en la celebración de la Mesa del Señor.

Es muy importante tener presente que la Eucaristía es fuente de todo lo que nosotros como cristianos hacemos y debemos hacer. Es mucho más que un "simple" rito que asistimos, sino que debe ser la participación activa y de adoración que cada uno de nosotros debe tener en ella. No venimos a recibir algo, sino que en cada celebración eucarística recibimos a Alguien, y ese Alguien es el mismo Jesús nuestro Salvador.

Hoy de manera especial, el Señor nos reúne en torno a su mesa, nos invita a alimentarnos de su Cuerpo Sagrado. Cada vez que pensemos en ellos, debe ser para nosotros un motivo de alegría y de compromiso personal. Jesús se nos dona y entrega, muchas veces somos nosotros que no queremos darle lo mejor para recibirlo en nuestras vidas.
