HEARING LOOP SYSTEM

If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. For those who do not have hearing aids, headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system are located in the Information Center for use during Mass.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Hello everyone! Peace of Christ!

It is with great joy to be assigned here in the Church of Holy Apostles as your pastor. Let me provide you a short introduction about myself.

I am Fr. Romeo Pavino. Everyone calls me Fr. Mio. I was born in Lucena City, in the province of Quezon, Philippines. I am the youngest of the ten children of †Ruben and †Violeta. At 13, I entered Our Lady of Mt. Carmel High School Seminary in Sariaya, Quezon. Then I took up Philosophy at St. Francis de Sales Major Seminary in Lipa, Batangas. Finally, I went to St. Alphonsus Regional Seminary for my Theologate.

I was ordained to the priesthood on September 8, 1998 by †Bishop Ruben Profugo of the Diocese of Lucena, Philippines.

I came here to the Diocese of Rockford in June, 2017 and was assigned as parochial vicar at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in Crystal Lake. After a year, I was transferred to Holy Cross Parish in Batavia as parochial vicar. On January, 2021, I was moved to St. Peter Parish in South Beloit and Church of the Holy Spirit, Roscoe, as parish administrator, and later became pastor.

It gave me great confidence that many of you have extended your early warm welcome through email and social media. I am so excited to be here and to serve you. Special thanks to Fr. Paul and Fr. Jhakson for their brotherly concern, giving me a sort of morale booster.

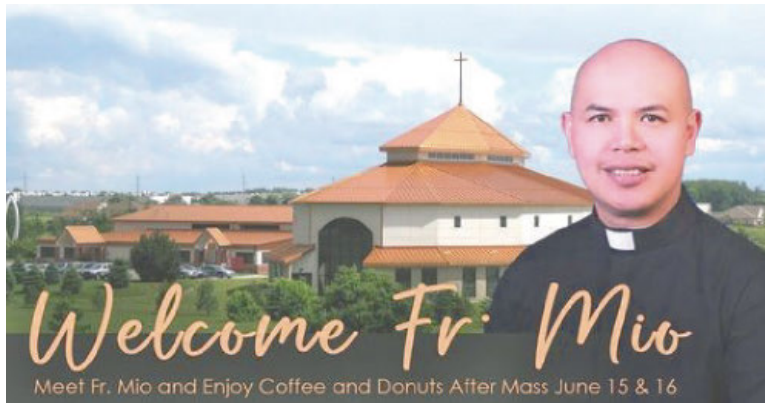

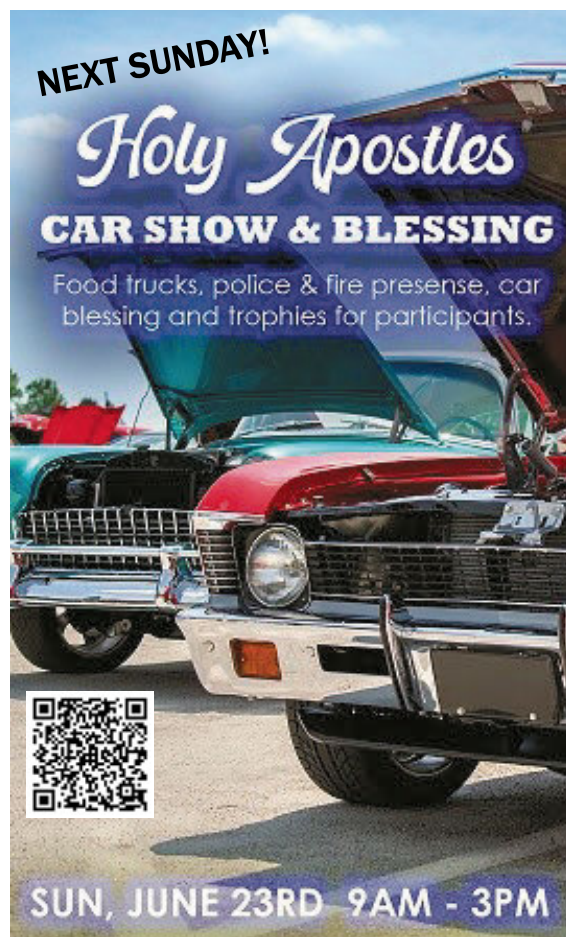
How You Can Help Your Neighbors in Need

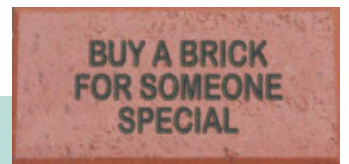

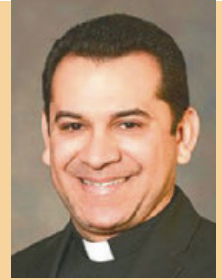

Catholics believe that “the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist” (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physical properties of bread, the **Real Presence of Jesus Christ**, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. 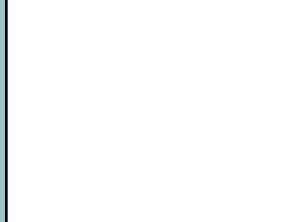
