A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

On June 29th we will be celebrating the feast day of St. Peter, the leader of the Apostles. Peter was a fisherman on the Sea of Galilee and was one of the first disciples to follow Jesus. After Pentecost, Peter became the leader of the apostles and travelled through Palestine and Asia Minor, where he worked multiple miracles and converted many followers.

Our parish is fortunate to be named Holy Apostles. We are under the guidance of saints who were personally called and chosen by Jesus Christ. As parishioners of the Church of the Holy Apostles we ought to have a special connection and devotion to them. This implies that we must have deeper knowledge about them and their missionary life.

Let us start by knowing the names of the apostles: Simon, whose name was changed to PETER by Jesus; ANDREW, the brother of Peter; JOHN, the beloved disciple, the youngest among the apostles and who wrote the fourth Gospel; JAMES, the brother of John whose father is Zebedee; PHILIP and BARTHOLOMEW; and MATTHEW, the tax collector; THOMAS, the twin and JAMES, son of Alphaeus; THADDAEUS, and SIMON the Cananaean; and MATTHIAS, replacing Judas Iscariot, who betrayed our Lord.

As we commemorate the feast of St. Peter, the leader of the Apostles, may God continue to shower us with His choicest blessings and may the mother of God, the Blessed Virgin Mary, place us under her maternal care. In Christ, Fr. Mio

Be an Adorer: Spend Some Time with Jesus

"But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he

who formed you, O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you: "I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

Have you ever considered Adoration? Catholics believe that "the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist" (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physi-



cal properties of bread, the **Real Presence of Jesus Christ**, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. Praying before the Eucharist, then, is praying before the presence of Jesus Christ.

DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI

Hermanos y hermanas, el domingo pasado las lecturas nos invitaban a confiar siempre en Dios. No sabemos cómo ni cuándo Dios actúa, pero lo que es seguro es que Él lo hace. De ahí la parábola del grano de mostaza, que Jesús hacía referencia no al tamaño sino a la calidad de la semilla: fuerte y resistente. Así debe ser nuestra confianza en Dios, especialmente en los momentos más difíciles.

Esta semana Jesús vuelve a habla de la fe y confianza cuando algo golpea nuestra existencia. No es una parábola, sino un hecho real sucedido. Una fuerte tormenta golpea la barca donde ellos van. El miedo y el temor a morir se hacen presentes.

Si lo aplicamos a nuestra vida, cada uno de nosotros navega su propia barca, por el mar de la vida. Y lógicamente las situaciones desafiantes van a llegar. Es lo más normal. Pero el punto no es que lleguen, sino mantenernos firmes en la fe, de saber que Jesús no nos abandona y nos ayudará.

Por lo general le pedimos a Dios que nos libre de malas situaciones, cuando en realidad lo que debemos pedir es ayuda y fortaleza para pasar y superar las situaciones de la vida que inevitablemente van a presentarse.

Es cierto que la fe no nos va a evitar que esos desafíos lleguen, pero esa fe nos va a mantener caminando siempre hacia adelante. Es la comparación de la sombrilla. Los paraguas no evitan que no llueva, pero nos ayudan a caminar a pesar de la lluvia.

Si decimos que somos cristianos que tienen vivimos según la fe, la pregunta que Jesús le hace a sus discípulos también es para nosotros: ¿por qué tenemos miedo? Yo pensaría también en otra pregunta: "¿A qué le tememos?".

Humanamente hablando sentir miedo es normal, por eso la fe y confianza en Dios nos ayuda a elevarnos a la parte divina de Dios que nos asegura que no estamos solos.

La fe es un don que necesitamos pedirle a Dios que nos lo fortalezca cada día. Debemos reconocer que, sin la ayuda de Dios, caemos fácilmente y cuando el miedo se apodera de nosotros, muchas veces terminamos alejándonos de Dios.

Dios nos ayude a tener una confianza y fe que se mantengan durante todos los momentos de nuestra vida, que cuando enfrentemos los desafíos de la vida podamos siempre superarlos con la ayuda de Dios.
