HEARING LOOP SYSTEM

If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. For those who do not have hearing aids, headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system are located in the Information Center for use during Mass.

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

This weekend's readings are about being family. I am very pleased that in my time here I feel we have become one family of many different ages, sizes, ethnicities, orientations and come from many places and live the golden rule to love God and one another, even when we do not agree. God calls us together to see the good in each other and bring it out.

It has been a very emotional and exhausting (in a good way) month saying good bye and reliving 12 years of Baptisms, funerals, weddings, Confirmations, graduations, Masses, deaths, walking with people through long illnesses, mission trips, seeing kids grow up celebrating wonderful and difficult moments. "But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you: "I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

Have you ever considered Adoration? Catholics believe that "the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist" (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physical properties of bread, the Real

Presence of Jesus Christ, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. Praying before the Eucharist, then, is praying before the presence of Jesus Christ. If you are interested in scheduling a permanent hour with Jesus or cannot commit weekly,
