Aprovecho para pedirles que recen por mí que estaré visitando a mi familia en Venezuela. Espero verlos a mi regreso y desde este momento les aseguro mis oraciones por todos y cada uno de ustedes.

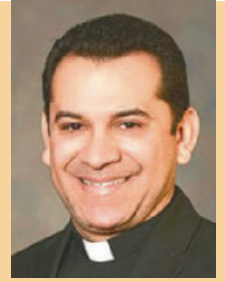


