HEARING LOOP SYSTEM

If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. Headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system in the Information Center for use during Mass.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,
“For the joy of the Lord is your strength.” Nehemiah 8:10
 In common vernacular, the word joy means “delight, happiness and pleasure.” However, from a biblical standpoint, joy is a powerful force that resides in your spirit once you’ve made Jesus the Lord of your life.

We are grateful to all of you who donated during the drive and also those who bought leftover candy, as it helps us in our mission to help those in need. May God bless you!

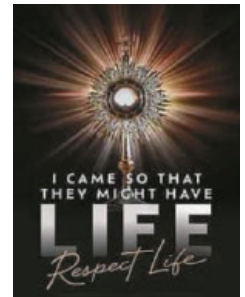

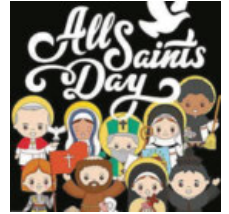

Come Visit Jesus: Commit to an Hour of Adoration

Catholics believe that "the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist" (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physical properties of bread, the **Real Presence of Jesus Christ**, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. Praying before the Eucharist, then, is praying before the presence of Jesus Christ. Schedule a permanent hour with Jesus, or if you cannot commit to a weekly time, sign-up as a substitute. Hermanos y hermanas, la semana pasada en el Evangelio del domingo Jesús nos enseñaba que la “parte faltante” para alcanzar la vida eterna, además de los mandamientos, es el desprendimiento y la ayuda a nuestros hermanos.

Este domingo Jesús sigue esa línea de enseñanza a sus discípulos: ante aquellos que quieren buscar posiciones de importancia, Nuestro Señor nos propone el servicio. En pocas palabras lo que nos quiere enseñar es que no es más importante la posición que ocupas, sino el servicio que hagas con ello.

En este mundo donde la gente pelea por ocupar posiciones, debemos tener presente que ninguna de ellas tendrá sentido, si solo la usamos como poder sobre los demás y no como el servicio a todos.

Esto me hace pensar en los sacerdotes. Ustedes han tenido la experiencia que muchos sacerdotes que han estado en nuestra parroquia, vienen de otros países. Si nos damos cuenta, cada uno de nosotros ha venido a servir, y como dice el Señor en el Evangelio “pasamos por esas mismas pruebas” que Él pasó.

Es muy fácil criticarnos cuando cometemos errores o cuando no hacemos lo que cada quien quiere, pero quiero invitarles a pensar en el servicio que damos: tenemos que atender a cada persona que viene con nosotros; debemos dar esperanza a aquellas personas que pasan por momentos difíciles, de igual forma comprender y ayudar a aquella persona que lo busca. Hemos dejado tierra, familia y todo, para poder servir a cada uno de ustedes y a todo aquel que necesite de nuestro servicio.

Lo que yo les preguntaría es: ¿cuántas veces oran por nosotros? ¿qué tan comprensivos son con nosotros? Yo no puedo entender cómo alguien que se dice cristiano y católico en vez de ayudar a su sacerdote, lo hunde y lo pone mal con malos comentarios con otras personas.

Eso es la idea que la segunda lectura de la Carta a los hebreos expresa. La figura del sumo sacerdote que se confía con Jesús, no solo en la parte divina, sino con las pruebas y dificultades que también Jesús pasó.

Yo no digo que los sacerdotes somos perfectos. Estoy consciente que también somos humanos pecadores que se equivocan. Pero también somos seres necesitados de sus oraciones y comprensión. También tenemos sentimientos, extrañamos a nuestras familias, lloramos y nos alegramos con las tristezas y alegrías de las personas que servimos. Pero, sobre todo queremos ser servidores como Cristo nos llama a serlo.

Por todo esto quiero adelantarme al día de acción de Gracias, agradeciendo a cada uno de ustedes las oraciones por los sacerdotes, especialmente aquellos que están pasando por momentos difíciles actualmente. Fr. Mío y mi persona queremos ser buenos servidores, dar lo mejor de nosotros que hemos dejado todo para seguir a Dios y ser sus servidores.

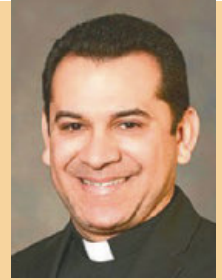

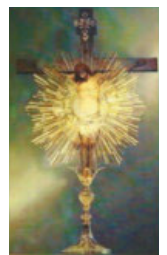

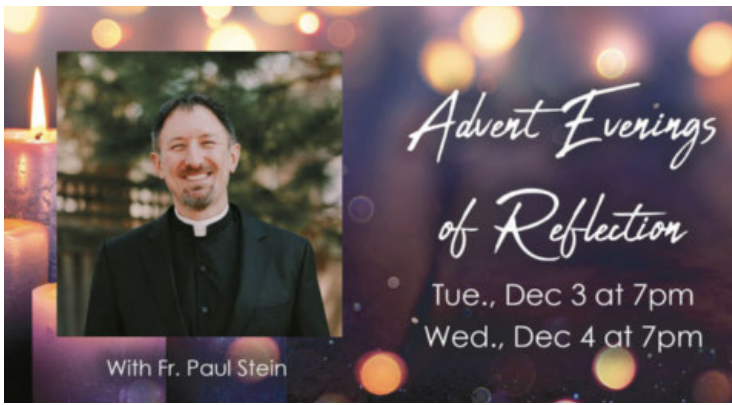
