If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. Headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system in the Information Center for use during Mass.

Dear brothers and sisters, Today's second reading expresses a great reality that we often forget and that is "every high priest is chosen from among men." Thinking about this, two questions come to mind: How often do we hear a priest talk about his personal things? Usually very little, because he is busy listening to and helping with the personal and spiritual needs of others.

The other question is: Why does a priest leave the priesthood? According to recent studies, a large number of priests resign every year. They do not resign because they have a lack of faith in God nor because they do not believe in the call that God has placed on their lives. Most do not even resign for financial reasons. Priests resign because they are overwhelmed by mental exhaustion.

We often see a priest very busy with parish tasks and trying to help others. Perhaps we say to ourselves: "that is his job, that is why he became a priest." And maybe we are right in thinking that, however, just because he is so busy with other people's things, it doesn't mean that he is not going through his own issues. We forget that aspect.

In the clerical world, we often say that only a priest can understand another priest. There are many things we have to take into consideration. A priest keeps his mind busy with the presentation of next Sunday's message—how to preach it, what to teach, how do we apply it? Being criticized continually.

Priests usually invest our whole lives in people and yet people will turn their backs on us at the first sign of a storm, usually without a conversation. Priests are in the middle of disputes. And priests also see the posts that are made about us; we hear the whispers and rumors that are made and we also endure the negativity.

We are chosen from among men, not from among angels, we feel and suffer like each one of you. You may wonder, what can I do? Well, from my personal point of view, as a human being, I don't ask you to pray for us, if you do we thank you, that depends on each one of you... but I do ask you to understand us, I think we deserve it.

What keeps a priest going on his journey? God, who called him, and especially you! Yes, you, that person who seeks Jesus and wants to follow him, who is hungry for truth.

Priests are human. They need you more than you think! In Christ, Fr. Jhakson

DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, la segunda lectura de este domingo expresa una gran realidad que muchas veces se nos olvida, y es que "todo sumo sacerdote, es elegido entre los hombres". Y pensando en esto se me vienen a la mente dos preguntas: ¿Qué tan frecuente escuchamos a un sacerdote hablé de sus cosas personales? Por lo general muy pocas, porque está ocupado escuchando y ayudando en las cosas personales y espirituales de los demás.

La otra pregunta es: ¿por qué un sacerdote deja el sacerdocio? Según estudios recientes, un gran número de sacerdotes renuncian cada año. No renuncian porque tienen una falta de fe en Dios. No renunciarán porque no creen en el llamado que Dios ha puesto en su vida. La mayora ni siquiera renuncia por razones financieras. Los sacerdotes renuncian porque están abrumados por el agotamiento mental.

Vemos muchas veces al sacerdote muy ocupado en cosas de la parroquia y tratando de ayudar a los demás, y tal vez nos digamos: "ese es su trabajo, para eso se hizo sacerdote"; y tal vez tengamos razón al pensar eso, sin embargo, que está tan ocupado en las cosas de los demás, no elimina que no esté pasando por sus propias situaciones. Se nos olvida ese aspecto.

En el mundo clerical decimos con frecuencia que solo un sacerdote, puede entender a otro sacerdote. Hay muchas cosas que tenemos que tener en consideración. Un sacerdote mantiene su mente ocupada con la presentación del próximo mensaje dominical - ¿cómo predicarlo, sobre qué enseñar, ¿cómo lo aplicamos? Ser criticado continuamente.

Los sacerdotes por lo general invertimos toda nuestra vida en personas y sin embargo, la gente nos dará la espalda en la primera señal de una tormenta, generalmente sin una conversación. Los sacerdotes estamos en medio de disputas. Y también los sacerdotes vemos las publicaciones que hacen sobre nosotros; escuchamos los susurros y rumores que se hacen y también soportamos la negatividad.

Somos escogidos entre los hombres, no entre los ángeles, sentimos y padecemos como cada uno de ustedes. Te preguntarás ¿qué puedes hacer?

Pues desde mi lado personal, como humano, no pido que recen por nosotros, si lo hacen se los agradecemos, eso depende de cada uno de ustedes...pero sí les pido que nos comprendan, creo que nos lo merecemos.

¿Qué mantiene a un sacerdote en marcha en su caminar? Dios quien lo llamó y especialmente ¡Tú!. Sí, tú, esa persona que busca a Jesús y quiere seguirlo, que tiene hambre de verdad.

Los sacerdotes, son humanos. ¡Ellos te necesitan más de lo que crees!




