Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

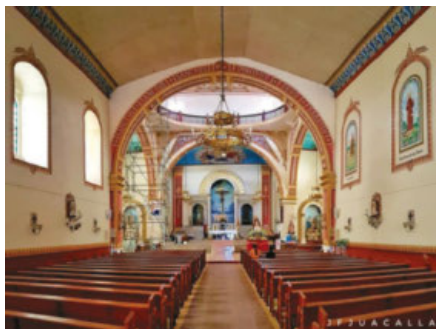
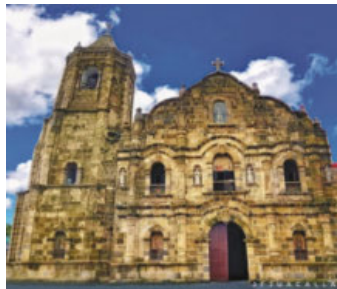
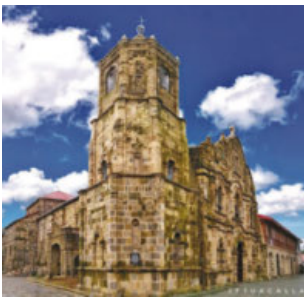
As you may already know, I am currently back home in the Philippines on my vacation. I am a native of a small town called Lucban, in the province of Quezon. Lucban currently has a population of about 55,000 people, of which more than 90% are Catholics. Lucban is dubbed the Summer Capital of the Province of Quezon. It is also well known for its annual Pahiyas Festival, which is held every May 15th in honor of San Isidro Labrador, the patron saint of farmers.

The Church of Lucban is under the tutelage of St. Louie Bishop. It was established by the Spanish friars in 1578. I am very proud to say that Lucban holds the title of producing the most number of priests in the whole province of Quezon, more than 100 priests to date. At present, there are two priests from Lucban who are serving in the Diocese of Rockford, Fr. Ejay Jarapa and myself.

En este mismo orden de ideas, cuando oramos, muchas veces le pedimos a Dios que nos libre de esas situaciones que nos golpean, lo cual está bien. Sin embargo, la oración muchas veces no nos quitará tales situaciones, pero lo que sí hará es hacer que nuestro caminar por esos momentos sea menos duros o difíciles.

Por eso ¿vale la pena rezar? Claro que sí vale la pena. ¿La fe nos ayuda? También es cierto, nos ayuda a seguir adelante, a no decaer.

Cada uno de nosotros pasa por momentos difíciles, y es muy humano pensar que es lo peor de este mundo. Pero, seguramente conocemos personas que han pasado y aún siguen pasando momentos más críticos que los de nosotros.

La oración hecha con el corazón, no solo nos acerca a Dios, sino también que nos ayuda a que nuestra fe en Él no decaiga, haciéndola más fuerte cada día.

Este inicio de mes, último trimestre del año, nos ayudará mucho reflexionar sobre el tiempo que le dedicamos a Dios, también meditar sobre la confianza que tenemos en ese Dios que nosotros decimos creer y al cual acudimos en nuestras oraciones.

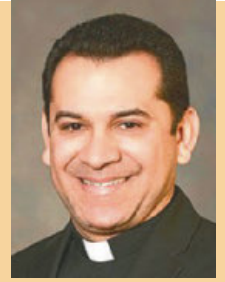
