If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. Catholics believe that “the Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist” (CCC 1377). This means that as long as the Sacred Host is intact and possesses the physical properties of bread, the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, body, blood, soul and divinity, remain. Praying before the Eucharist, then, is praying before the presence of Jesus Christ. Schedule a permanent hour with Jesus, or if you cannot commit to a weekly time, sign-up as a substitute.

Celebrating Our Blessed Mother in December

Sunday, December 8, is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception celebrating the Blessed Virgin Mary being conceived without original sin in preparation for becoming the Mother of God. It is a Holy Day of Obligation but since December 8th is a Sunday, **the Holy Day will be observed on Monday, December 9th. Masses are at 7:30 AM, 12:10 PM, 5:30 PM and in Spanish at 7 PM.**



Thursday, December 12, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patron saint of Mexico and a major holiday for Mexican people, will be celebrated here at Holy Apostles beginning at 5 AM Mañanitas (morning prayers/songs), Rosary and refreshments. Then at 5 PM there will be traditional dancers followed by the Rosary, 7 PM Mass and ending with refreshments and fellowship in Sherry Center. *(All Guadalupe events are in Spanish.)*

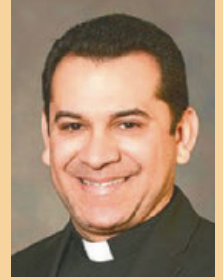

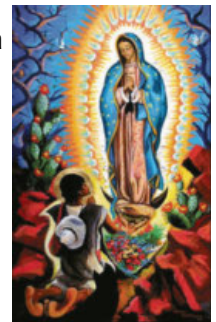


