A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

A young man was looking for a church. He was new to the place and he was wanting to know where the church was located. He approached an old man to inquire where the church was. The old man responded by saying: *WE ARE THE CHURCH.*

Growing up, I had this limited concept of the church, that the church is the building where we pray and worship God. It was only when I entered the seminary that I learned and realized that the Church was not limited to the idea that it was just an edifice. The word Church is derived from the German word *Kirche* which literally means “assembly of people.” Assembly of people in Greek is called *Ekklesia*. St. Robert Cardinal Bellarmine has a beautiful definition of the Church. According to him the Church is “the assembly of the faithful in the profession of the same Christian faith, and in the communion of the same sacraments, under the reign of a legitimate pastor, and especially of the one vicar of Christ on earth, the Roman Pontiff.”

Drawing from this definition, the church is primarily an assembly...a gathering of people who believes in Christ. It does not, however, limit the concept of gathering as referring to just the act of coming together. The Church, therefore, strictly speaking is not the building but the people—the faithful believers of Jesus Christ. WE ARE THE CHURCH. We are THE CHURCH OF HOLY APOSTLES. If we are the Church, it is essential that we know our place in the Church, so that, we can involve ourselves in the life and mission of the Church.

Even when I first started here at Holy Apostles, people already approached me and offered their help. These past few days there were again people approaching me, expressing their intention to be involved in the life of the Church. One signified his intention to help in the Evangelization program of the parish and even suggested an effective way to evangelize. Another expressed her willingness to help the youth in our parish and revive some past activities. It is extremely inspiring to me when people are aware that we are the Church.

Let me end my article with an analogy I saw about the Church: **THE CHURCH IS NOT A CRUISE SHIP WHERE A HANDFUL OF PEOPLE SERVE EVERYONE ELSE WHO IS RELAXING. NO, THE CHURCH IS A BATTLESHIP WHERE IT’S “ALL HANDS ON DECK” AND EVERYONE SERVES THE MISSION.**

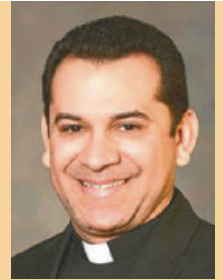

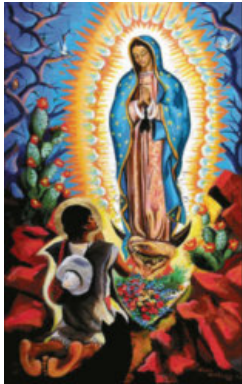
