If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. ### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

### **Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,**

Forgiveness is one of God's greatest gifts to us. Jesus demonstrated His forgiveness towards us by dying on the cross. And yet, sometimes it's so hard for us to forgive our family or friends – and especially our enemies, but always remember that the hardest is to forgive ourselves.

Forgiveness is the giving, and so the receiving, of life. It is defined as a conscious, deliberate decision to release feelings of resentment or vengeance toward a person or group who has harmed you, regardless of whether they actually deserve your forgiveness.

There are two sides to forgiveness: giving and receiving. Although at first sight giving seems to be harder, it often appears that we are not able to offer forgiveness to others because we have not been able fully to receive it. Only as people who have accepted forgiveness can we find the inner freedom to give it.

Why is receiving forgiveness so difficult? It is very hard to say, "Without your forgiveness I am still bound to what happened between us. Only you can set me free." That requires not only a confession that we have hurt somebody but also the humility to acknowledge our dependency on others. Only when we can receive forgiveness can we give it.



### **Celebrating Our Blessed Mother in December**

Sunday, December 8, is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception celebrating the Blessed Virgin Mary being conceived without original sin in preparation for becoming the Mother of God. It is a Holy Day of Obligation but since December 8th is a Sunday, the Holy Day will be observed on Monday, December 9th. Masses will be celebrated at 7:30 AM, 12:10 PM, 5:30 PM and in Spanish at 7 PM.



Thursday, December 12, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patron saint of Mexico and a major holiday for Mexican people, will be celebrated here at Holy Apostles beginning at 5 AM Mañanitas (morning prayers/songs), Rosary and refreshments. Then at 5 PM there will be traditional dancers followed by the Rosary, 7 PM Mass and ending with refreshments and fellowship in Sherry Center. (All Guadalupe events are in Spanish.)

### **Do You Need Low-Cost Legal Help?**




