#### **Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,**

#### Stroke Scan Plus Screening Offered

Stroke Scan Plus will offer a Stroke, Vascular and Abdominal Ultrasound Screening here at Holy Apostles on Friday, January 31 and Saturday, February 1. The scans will check the carotid arteries in the neck for fatty plaque build-up which accounts for 80% of strokes, the abdominal aorta for aneurysms, the thyroid which controls the metabolism for cysts, nodules and enlargements, the liver, gallbladder and kidneys for cysts, masses and tumors. These screenings are typically not part of annual physicals nor will insurance companies pay for them unless your symptomatic. Stroke Scan will offer these screenings for \$169 for all of them. Health/flex savings accounts are accepted. A representative will be here January 18/19 to answer questions and for registration. Payment is due at day of screening. Call 832-437-7355 to make your appointment. "Prevention is the key to early detection."

There is no requirement that a doctor or anyone be present with a person should something go wrong when consuming the drugs. The person may take hours to die.


