A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

During the Advent Season, we remember the BLESSED VIRGIN MARY in a very special way, acknowledging and recognizing the role she played in the eternal plan of salvation. With the Archangel Gabriel, we proclaim: "Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with you. Blessed are you among women." However, Mary is not the only one blessed by God. Through her Son, Jesus, we, too, have been blessed by God, both materially and spiritually. The only reason why we do not realize this, and why we continue to have inner conflict and disharmony is the reign of sin in our lives. Sin is basically disobedience to God. Mary is great, not only because of her unique gift and privilege of the IMMACULATE CON-CEPTION, but mainly due to her TOTAL and UNCONDITION-AL OBEDIENCE to the will of God: "Be it done unto me according to your word." Celebrating Our Blessed Mother in December

Today, December 8, is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception celebrating the Blessed Virgin Mary being conceived without original sin in preparation for becoming the Mother of God. It is a Holy Day of Obligation but since December 8th is a Sunday, the Holy Day will be observed tomorrow, December 9th. Masses are at 7:30 AM, 12:10 PM, 5:30 PM and in Spanish at 7 PM.

Thursday, December 12, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patron saint of Mexico and a major holiday for Mexican people, will be celebrated here at Holy Apostles beginning at 5 AM Mañanitas (morning prayers/songs), Rosary and refreshments. Then at 5 PM there will be traditional dancers followed by the Rosary, 7 PM Mass and ending with refreshments and fellowship in Sherry Center. (All Guadalupe events are in Spanish.)
