DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI

Hermanos y hermanas, ante todo quiero expresarle a cada uno de ustedes mis más profundas palabras de agradecimiento por la celebración de mi 20 aniversario de ordenación, especialmente a los que estuvieron presente acompañándome y aquellos que aportaron su granito de arena para que fuese posible. Se dice rápido, pero el tiempo pasa y es increíble cómo ya han pasado 20 años.

Este domingo celebramos la Solemnidad de la Presentación del Señor. En muchos lugares se le conoce como el día de la Candelaria, porque es cuando se bendicen los cirios; pero también en algunos lugares se le llama el día de la "paradura" del Niño Dios.

Cuando hablamos de la Presentación del Señor en templo, podemos ver que María y José, cumplen lo que está establecido por la ley judía: después de los 40 día de nacido, debe presentarse en el templo al niño. Pero también constituye un momento de la purificación de María.

En este caso de purificación, después del parto, María queda "impura". La idea de impureza en el Antiguo Testamento no es la que tenemos hoy. No es una falta moral. La mujer que trae un niño al mundo ha entrado en contacto con el poder creador de Dios y, debido a la indignidad de la persona humana, la contamina: se vuelve ritualmente impura.

Hay que recordar que, en la mentalidad antigua, estar en contacto con la sangre vuelve impuro a la persona y por tanto no puede participar en las celebraciones en el Templo. Por eso, La purificación manifiesta que se reconoce y respeta la santidad de Dios.

Podemos encontrar muchos pasajes que hacen referencia a ello. Uno de los más famosos es el del buen samaritano, que herido, pasaron varias personas y nadie lo ayudó por temor a quedar impuros, es decir, fuera de la posibilidad de poder participar en las celebraciones en el templo, más aún si se trataba de un sacerdote o levita del antiguo Israel.

Otro punto importante en este día es el cumplimiento de las promesas de Dios. Decimos que Dios es fiel y siempre cumple lo que promete. Simeón había recibido la promesa de no morir sin haber visto al Salvador. Y así fue, Dios cumplió lo que le había dicho.

Para nosotros esta celebración debe recordarnos dos cosas, la primera es que nosotros debemos cumplir con todo aquello que Dios nos establece para honrarlo, adorarlo y ponerlo como principal en nuestras vidas. Segundo, a cada acción que nosotros hacemos por Dios, Él nos regala una bendición cumpliendo sus promesas.

Hoy en esta solemnidad demos gracias a Dios porque es Fiel, no deja nunca de cumplir lo que nos dice y promete; Dios solo nos pide que permanezcamos fieles a Él cumpliendo todo aquello que nos ha dejado como mandato para poder vivir mejor.
