A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Holy Apostles Parish Family,

This year, the Catholic world celebrates Jubilee Year 2025, the first ordinary jubilee since the Great Jubilee of 2000. A jubilee is a special holy year of grace and pilgrimage in the Catholic Church.

Ever since 1300, when Pope Boniface VIII instituted the first Holy Year, it was initially celebrated every 100 years. Then following its biblical precedent-the Jubilee Year in Israel-it was celebrated every 50 years; and finally every 25 years. However, the Pope can call for extraordinary jubilee years more often, such as in the case of the 2016 Year of Mercy called by Pope Francis or the 2013 Year of Faith by Pope Benedict XVI.

Jubilee Year 2025 coincides with the celebrations for the 1,700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea, the first ecumenical council of the Christian Church. It produced the Nicene Creed which is used in the Mass along with the Apostles' Creed.

The word "jubilee" is derived from the Hebrew word youbel, which means "ram's horn," since it was precisely the sound of the horn which was used as a trumpet that indicated to everybody the beginning of the jubilee year. The book of Leviticus tells us of the significance of the jubilee year, a year of liberation "par excellence," which is at the end of seven weeks of years, the 50th year.

You shall count seven weeks of years seven times seven years-such that the seven weeks of years amount to fortynine years. Then, on the tenth day of the seventh month let the ram's horn resound; on this, the Day of Atonement, the ram's horn blast shall resound throughout your land. You shall treat this fiftieth day as sacred. You shall proclaim liberty in the land for all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, when each of you shall return to your own property, each of you to your own family.

This fiftieth year is your year of jubilee; you shall not sow, nor shall you reap the aftergrowth or pick the untrimmed vines, since this is the jubilee. It shall be sacred for you.

You may only eat what the field yields of itself (25:8-12). The Leviticus legislation has three main elements, namely: rest of the soil; the return of the land property to each original owner forced by poverty to sell it; and the freeing or manumission of those Israelites who, through

poverty or otherwise, had become slaves of their fellow Israelites. At the heart of a fundamental expression and proposal

of experiences in the jubilee year is REST—a rest which is not just a cessation of activity, but points to human beings' relationship with God. Everything is God's gifts, and human beings are able to refer everything to him. The gift of shabbath (rest) leads a person to the reason of his or her existence, to his or her own roots, and opens to happiness and consolation in life.

Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

Pope Francis inaugurated the Jubilee Year 2025 with the rite of the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica on December 24, 2024. After that, the Holy Doors of the other papal basilicas-St. John Lateran, St. Paul Outside the Walls, and St. Mary Majorare opened and remain so until the end of the Jubilee Year. Holy Doors of "Jubilee churches" in other parts of the world will also open for pilgrims who will not make it to Rome.

The motto of the Jubilee chosen by Pope Francis is PEREGRINAN-TES IN SPEM (Pilgrims of Hope). Life, in essence, is a pilgrimage, and man is viator (traveler), undergoing the stages and changes of life until he completes his life's journey. Man is a traveler thirsty for new horizons, hungry for justice and peace, and searching for truth about life and himself. The Jubilee is a time of pilgrimages, of going to places where travelers hope to encounter God who gives meaning to their lives.

Stroke Scan Plus Screening Offered

Stroke Scan Plus will offer a Stroke, Vascular and Abdominal Ultrasound Screening at Holy Apostles on Friday, January 31 and Saturday, February 1. The scans will check the carotid arteries in the neck for fatty plaque build-up which accounts for 80% of strokes, the abdominal aorta for aneurysms, the thyroid which controls the metabolism for cysts, nodules and enlargements, the liver, gallbladder and kidneys for cysts, masses and tumors.

These screenings are typically not part of annual physicals nor will insurance companies pay for them unless you're symptomatic. Stroke Scan will offer these screenings for \$169 for all of them. Health/flex savings accounts are accepted. A representative will be here January 18/19 to answer questions and for registration. Payment is due at day of screening. Call **832-437-7355** to make your appointment.

NAMI McHenry County Offers Mental Health First Aid

National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) of McHenry County will offer Adult and Youth Mental Health First Aid classes for anyone who is inter-



Hermanos y hermanas, con la celebración de la Solemnidad del Bautismo del Señor, concluimos el tiempo de la Navidad y damos inicio al tiempo Ordinario. Y durante este tiempo vamos a estar escuchando las acciones y enseñanzas de la vida pública de Jesús.

Hablar de la vida pública de Jesús, no se trata simplemente de saber qué fue lo que hizo, sino poner de relieve el "porqué". Nuestro Señor, en primer lugar, inicia esta etapa de su vida después de recibir el bautismo de parte de Juan el Bautista.

A diferencia de nuestro bautismo, el de Jesús no se trata de un bautismo para perdonar los pecados, sino que quiere resaltar la misión que iniciará.

Cada uno de nosotros hemos sido bautizado, y con ello se nos perdona el pecado original. Pero lo que nos acomuna con el Bautismo del Señor, es que también nosotros hemos sido llamados para una misión, predicar el evangelio y el regreso a Dios.

Este aspecto es muy significativo para poder entender, no solo nuestro propio bautizo, sino también la responsabilidad que podamos tener como padres, padrinos, a la hora de llevar a nuestros hijos a recibir el Sacramento.

No debemos pensar sólo en el niño; eso está bien y es importante, pero debemos también incluir en nuestra intención de bautizar, la responsabilidad que estamos adquiriendo delante de Dios, de educar en la fe, caminar con nuestros hijos y ser ejemplo de fe para ellos.

El Sacramento del bautismo no se puede quedar en un simple requisito previo, para poder acceder a los demás sacramentos ni mucho menos puede ser transformado en una simple tradición católica que se trasmite de generación en generación.

Por el contrario, debe ser nuestra manifestación de fe a Dios y su Iglesia, de modo tal que estamos conscientes que le estamos dando lo mejor a nuestros hijos y que nos comprometemos a esa misión que hemos sido llamados y hemos recibido.

Las palabras que el Padre le dirige a Jesús: "Tú eres mi Hijo, el Predilecto..." también son palabras que van dirigidas a cada uno de nosotros. Dios se complace en cada uno de nosotros, porque a través del Sacramento del Bautismo nos hace parte de su Cuerpo, una vez y para siempre.

Hay que darle verdadero valor al Sacramento del Bautismo, ahí radica nuestra misión de llevar a Jesús a todos los hombres. No es una opción, sino un deber de cada uno de nosotros.
