### A YEAR OF THE LORD'S FAVOR

Against this background of the custom of jubilees in Israel, Jesus of Nazareth goes back one day to the synagogue of his hometown and stands up to read from the book of the Prophet Isaiah. He finds this passage: *The spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me; he has sent me to bring good news to the afflicted, to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, release to the prisoners, to announce a year of favor from the Lord* (Is. 61:1-2).

Jesus then adds, "Today this scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing" (Lk 4:21), thus indicating that he himself is the Lord's Anointed, the Messiah foretold by the Prophet. The long awaited "time" of salvation is beginning. In him-the "fullness of time," the time of salvation, has come. Pope John Paul II explains. "All Jubilees point to this 'time' and refer to the Messianic mission of Christ, who came as the one 'anointed' by the Holy Spirit, the one 'sent by the Father'" (Tertio Millennio Adveniente, 11).

The Pope further notes that the prescriptions for the jubilee year in Israel largely remained ideals more a hope than an actual fact. They thus became a propheta futuri, a prophecy of the future, insofar as they foretold the freedom which would be won by the coming Messiah. Even so, on the basis of the juridical norms contained in these prescriptions a kind of social doctrine began to emerge, which would then more clearly develop beginning with the New Testament. Such doctrine includes protection of the weak, the idea that the whole of creation is for the common good of the whole humanity, the restoration of social justice, and the protection and care of the environment.

Moreover, what needs to be emphasized is what Isaiah expresses in words, "a year of the Lord's favor" (Hebrew: shenat razon le yahweh). John Paul II explains, "For the Church, the Jubilee is precisely this year of the Lord's favor, a year of the remission of sins and of the punishments due to them, a year of reconciliation between disputing parties, a year of manifold conversions and of sacramental and extra-sacramental penance. The tradition of jubilee years involves the granting of indulgences on a larger scale than at other times" (Tertio Millennio Adveniente, 14).
