Jubilee 2025: Pilgrims of Hope

Pope Francis inaugurated the Jubilee Year 2025 with the rite of the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica on December 24, 2024. After that, the Holy Doors of the other papal basilicas—St. John Lateran, St. Paul Outside the Walls, and St. Mary Major—are opened and remain so until the end of the Jubilee Year. Holy Doors of "Jubilee churches" in other parts of the world will also open for pilgrims who will not make it to Rome.

The motto of the Jubilee chosen by Pope Francis is PERGRINANTES IN SPEM (Pilgrims of Hope). Life, in essence, is a pilgrimage, and man's viator (traveler), undergoing the stages and changes of life until he completes his life's journey. Man is a traveler thirsty for new horizons, hungry for justice and peace, and searching for truth about life and himself. The Jubilee is a time of pilgrimages, of going to places where travelers hope to encounter God who gives meaning to their lives.

DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI

Hermanos y hermanas, espero en Dios hayan pasado una semana sin ningún contratiempo por el frío que estuvo presente hasta mediado de esta semana.

Pues bien, como ya saben y les he anunciado, el próximo miércoles enero 29, cumpliré 20 años de haber sido ordenado sacerdote. El tiempo pasa muy rápido y parece que fue ayer cuando mi obispo de aquel entonces me dijo: “Dios que ha iniciado esta obra buena en ti, Él mismo la lleve a feliz término”.

¿Qué les puedo decir de estos 20 años de ministerio? No puedo decir nada que no sea otra cosa que GRACIAS. Ha sido una bendición de Dios y hoy confirmo que es Él quien me ha guiado y llevado a pesar de mis temores. Así que este miércoles 29 celebraré la misa en acción de gracias por esos 20 años, a las 6:30pm. Espero verlos ahí, es el mayor regalo que pueden hacerme.

La segunda lectura de este domingo sigue la idea de la semana pasada: somos diferentes, cada uno tiene un servicio, pero todos debemos y trabajar por el bien de todos, ya que todos formamos parte del cuerpo de Cristo.

En esa misma lectura hay una frase que debemos meditar: “nadie puede decirle al otro *‘no te necesito’*”. San Pablo quiere hacer entender a la comunidad cristiana de Corinto que las peleas por ser el principal o el más importantes, no tienen ningún sentido. Todo tiene y cobra su sentido si hacemos partícipes al otro.

Cada ministerio y servicio que nosotros hacemos, debe estar guiado e iluminado por el don que hemos recibido. Una vez se afirma que, en el Cuerpo de Cristo, no todos podemos ser Ojos ni manos, sino que cada uno de nosotros tiene una función específica. Y desde ahí debemos cumplir la tarea que Dios nos encomienda.

Las luchas por prevalecer uno sobre el otro, no son de Dios, es totalmente contrario a lo que San Pablo dice en su carta, la Iglesia nos enseña, pero sobre todo lo que Dios quiere. En la Iglesia no podemos prescindir de nadie.

Aun mucho más profundo es “si una parte sufre, todo el cuerpo sufre”. No es solo solidaridad, sino se trata de pertenencia. Todos pertenecemos a este Cuerpo Místico llamado Iglesia, y la necesidad de un hermano, debe llevarme a pensar que también son necesidades que cada uno de nosotros debe tratar de ayudar a mejorar.

De una manera especial me gustaría que todos pudiésemos meditar sobre la necesidad del otro, todos somos importantes en la formación del Cuerpo de Cristo. Cada uno tiene algo valioso que aportar. En Cristo, **Fr. Jhakson**

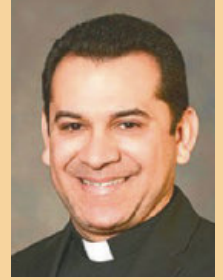
