If you use hearing aids or have a cochlear implant with a telecoil or "T" coil, flip the switch and you will have the priest's spoken word or the music fed directly into your hearing aid, eliminating background noise. Headphones enabling the use of the Hearing Loop system in the Information Center for use during Mass.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

The devil appeared to three monks and said to them: If I gave you the power to change something in the past, what would you change? The first of them, with great apostolic fervor, answered: "I would prevent you from causing Adam and Eve to fall into sin, so that mankind would not be separated from God." 

DE PADRE JHAKSON PARA TI

Hermanos y hermanas, cada año los sacerdotes tenemos momentos de encuentro y formación. Aunque somos ministros sacerdotales, también necesitamos un momento de fraternidad, oración y actualización.

Este lunes 10 de febrero hasta el d=a miércoles, todos los sacerdotes de la diócesis estaremos en las conferencias de invierno. Ahí estaremos compartiendo temas sobre nuestro sacerdocio y sobre los desafíos que enfrentamos actualmente.

La petición que les hago es orar por nosotros. Cada momento de reunión significa para nosotros, un momento oportuno para reafirmar lo que somos y hacemos.

En otro orden de ideas, el martes 11 de febrero, celebramos a Nuestra Señora de Lourdes, patrona de los enfermos. Y con ella, ese día, celebramos la jornada mundial de oración por los enfermos.

Cuando hablamos de enfermos, no solo hacemos referencia a aquellas personas que sufren enfermedades terminales. La jornada de Oración también va dirigida a cada persona que se sienta quebrantada por situaciones físicas, mentales y espirituales, y el tema va de la mano con el año Jubilar que estamos celebrando: "la esperanza no defrauda".

El Papa nos invita a reflexionar sobre los tres momentos que la presencia de Dios en quien sufre, bajo tres aspectos: el encuentro, el don y el compartir. Al hablar sobre el "encuentro" "la enfermedad entonces se convierte en ocasión de un encuentro que nos transforma", porque Jesús se compadece de nosotros y muestra su cercanía porque Él mismo experimentó nuestra fragilidad humana.

El Papa habla de "Don", es en el "sufrimiento nos damos cuenta de que toda esperanza viene del Señor, y que por eso es, ante todo, un don que hemos de acoger y cultivar, permaneciendo "fieles a la fidelidad de Dios". La esperanza es un Don que se fortalece cuando nos sentimos decaídos y quebrantados.

El aspecto del "Compartir". Los lugares donde se sufre son a menudo lugares de intercambio, de enriquecimiento mutuo. Nos podemos dar cuenta que nuestros propios sufrimientos, cuando lo compartimos con esperanza, pueden alentar a aquellos que la han perdido y buscan una respuesta a sus inquietudes.

La enfermedad es fruto o consecuencia de nuestra debilidad humana, causada por el pecado. La oración hecha con esperanza por todos aquellos que buscan sanación, es parte de nuestro deber cristiano. Que esta jornada de oración mundial, nos ayude a unirnos más para dar esperanza a aquellos que pasan por momentos difíciles.


